Planning success

In January 2021 we secured planning permission to regenerate the Sutton Estate. This means the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea have backed our vision to create a sustainable community in the heart of London. We will improve the whole estate, creating green spaces and bringing back in to use 81 much needed homes in blocks A to D.

The vision for **Sutton Estate**

We shaped the plan for the estate with existing residents and improvements will provide homes based on housing need and create an attractive place to live.

- 81 accessible and adaptable refurbished homes, most with private outdoor space
- · Lift access to all floors in every building
- New secure green heart and improvements for the Sunken Garden
- Integrated play trails, seating and social areas
- Improved bin and cycle storage
- New door entry systems
- 100% low cost homes to rent
- New caretaker building and store




Contractors are already on site upgrading homes in blocks E to O.

- 113 homes have received kitchen, bathroom and boiler upgrades
- 149 more homes will be refurbished by the summer
- Lift replacement work to blocks E to O to begin Spring 2021

There have been some delays due to concerns about the Coronavirus. We are following government guidance and doing everything we can to keep our residents and staff safe.

What happens next?

The regeneration will take around two years and we will update you regularly throughout the process. Over the next few months you will see some activity in the neighbourhood and more work on site in the summer when we start getting the properties ready for refurbishment. Our priority is to ensure the safety of residents and keep the disruption to a minimum.

We will send information and feedback forms in the post to residents who do not have access to the internet.


