Update from Durkan

DURKAN

Progress of works:

- Demolition is now underway at the development to the internal structural walls in block A
- Brickwork repairs are now underway to blocks A and B
- The lift shaft is at present being constructed in all blocks on site
- All foundations have been concreted for the new estate office and the sub-station
- Roofing repairs to roof timbers have been successfully completed to blocks A and B with replacement roof covering which is now being underway
- We will be looking to start installing windows as from 6th February to block A
- Brickwork to the estate office will also commence on 6th February
