New public realm on site of existing estate office

#### Early works to begin

After many years of discussion and debate the regeneration of the Sutton Estate is finally underway. The Wooldridge Group have been appointed to carry out the early preparation works on blocks A to D. Wooldridge will be on site until mid-summer, preparing the flats for refurbishment.


We are in the process of procuring a contractor to carry out the main refurbishment works. Once appointed the contractor will begin work on blocks A to D in late summer. We will also transform the outdoor space as part of the regeneration.

## What happens next?

Work to refurbish homes in blocks A to D will begin soon. Over the next few weeks you will see site preparation works taking place.

You will see hoarding going up around blocks A to D, near the estate office, to secure the site and keep you safe. We will concentrate on internal works, stripping out redundant finishes and services and preparing the flats for refurbishment. There will be lots of activity on the estate when Wooldridge arrives but we will keep the disruption to a minimum. This phase of work will continue through spring and summer and we will update you at each stage of the programme.





#### Upgrade update

Upgrade works on the existing homes on the rest of the estate continues. Wates are carrying out this work. We are modernising homes by installing new kitchens and bathrooms, and subject to planning permission, we will replace windows and door entry systems while preserving the character and appearance of the buildings.



We have completed upgrades on 146 homes in blocks E to O so far, including new kitchens, bathrooms, boilers and electrical works. Currently, improvements are being made to around 20 homes with more to be booked in over the next few months.

Lift contractors have been appointed to start upgrade works on the lifts in blocks E to O in the late summer and this will continue until spring 2022.
